 <p><b>Largemouth Bass</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• corner of mouth extends beyond eye</li> <li>• broad dark solid or broken stripe across side from eye to tail</li> <li>• dark vertical stripe on back</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• shallow, weedy water near dense vegetation for cover</li> <li>• prefers warm water</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• worms or surface lures</li> </ul>	25 - 55 cm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• season starts last Saturday in June until November 30</li> <li>• Limit (2) for conservation licence and (6) in one day or a combination of Largemouth and Smallmouth Bass to total (6) for standard licence</li> </ul>
 <p><b>Rock Bass</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• speckled, olive brown</li> <li>• red eyes</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• near shoreline of cool lakes, ponds and slow-moving streams and rivers</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• worms, minnows, small spinners</li> </ul>	15 - 20 cm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• no season or limit</li> </ul>
 <p><b>Bullhead</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• flat head, no scales</li> <li>• barbels near nose, mouth corners in chin</li> <li>• sharp spine on dorsal and pectoral fins</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• bottom feeder in deeper lakes and sluggish rivers</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• worms, dough balls or corn kernels</li> </ul>	20 - 36 cm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• no season or limit</li> </ul>
 <p><b>Yellow Perch</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• distinct vertical bars along sides</li> <li>• dark green back, greenish yellow sides</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• broad range of habitats</li> <li>• warm or cold lakes, ponds, rivers and streams</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• worms or minnows, near bottom</li> <li>• flies or small spinners near surface</li> </ul>	15 - 30 cm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• open all year</li> <li>• Limit (25) for conservation licence, (50) for standard licence</li> </ul>
 <p><b>Northern Pike</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• long, greenish body with many light spots</li> <li>• mouth long and narrow with sharp, pointed teeth</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• cool lakes, large ponds, rivers, near weedy shoreline</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• still-water fishing with minnows and frogs</li> <li>• casting with large plugs and flashy spoons</li> </ul>	45 - 100 cm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• January 1 to March 31 and second Saturday in May to December 31</li> <li>• Limit (2) for conservation licence, (6) for standard licence</li> </ul>
 <p><b>Pumpkinseed</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• wavy blue-green lines near eyes and gills</li> <li>• red spot near gill cover</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• still, shallow water with vegetative cover</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• flies, floating bug lures and bait on a small hook</li> </ul>	18 - 23 cm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• no season or limit</li> </ul>
 <p><b>White Sucker</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• sucker-like mouth</li> <li>• dark olive or brown back</li> <li>• creamy white belly</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• bottom feeders in warm shallow water</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• still-water fishing with worms</li> </ul>	30 - 50 cm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• no season or limit</li> </ul>
 <p><b>Carp</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• bronze with thick scales</li> <li>• pale yellow body</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• adapts to wide variety of water conditions</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• still-water fishing with worms, dough ball or corn kernels</li> </ul>	30 - 75 cm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• no season or limit</li> </ul>
