

Pets are welcome in our Conservation Areas. However, pet owners that do not comply with the Conservation Area Regulations may face fines and a possible eviction.

Don't let your pet become an outlaw!

DOG HOLIDAY AKA: "The Barker"

Charged with:

Disturbing the peace with uncontrolled barking. (Dog Holiday was left alone at the campsite.)

Fine: \$75.00

WILD ROSE AKA: "The Runner"



Charged with:

Running through the park off leash.

Second charge:

Frightening or provoking wildlife.

Fine: \$75.00

DOG PADDLE CHARLIE AKA: "The Swimmer"



Charged with:

Swimming at the Public Beach. Dogs are PROHIBITED from this area.

Fine: \$75.00

DIRTY DUKE AKA: "The Dirty Dog"



Charged with:

Leaving his droppings in a public place. (His owner did not clean up after him.)

Fine: \$125.00

SNEAKERS McGEE AKA: "The Sneak"



Charged with:

Entering a Public Structure. (Pets are prohibited from all public structures.)

Fine: \$50.00

CHEWEY LAROU AKA: "The Destroyer"



Charged with:

Destroying park property as well as the property of other visitors.

Fine: \$125.00

If you come in contact with any of these

OUTLAWS

contact your Conservation Area Office. The above fines may be issued.

Prevent your pet from becoming an outlaw.

- No pets at the beachNo pets in public structures
- Control your dog's barkingKeep your pet on a leash at all times

NOTE: Fines DO NOT include victim fine surcharge and administration fee with the minimum set fine. See legislation governing behaviour in Conservation Areas at www.e-laws.gov.on.ca.
